Dear Prospective Summer Academy Teacher:

You are invited to apply for a teaching position with the AEF 2019 Elementary School Summer Academy. This is a major program run by AEF to serve students of AUSD and the community at large. We are seeking teachers for grades K-8 for enrichment and 'getting ready' classes for all grades. Please complete the attached application and submit with requested documents to the Alhambra Educational Foundation office by **MARCH 8, 2019.**

- This year's elementary Summer Academy will be held at Ynez School and Alhambra High School.
- Classes will be held Monday through Friday beginning June 10 and ending on July 12.
Five (5) days a week for five (5) weeks. (Note change from previous summer programs)
- Pay for all teachers, regardless of AUSD salary schedule is \$40 per hour. "Full time" Salary is based on a 5.25-hour day (4 hours of class time, .25 break; 1 hour prep per day.) Salary for only one morning class (2 hours) or an additional 2-hour 'afterschool' classes is based on a 2.5-hour day (2 hours of class time and .5 prep per day). July 4 is a non-paid holiday.
- A mandatory curriculum training and planning day will be held on Thursday, June 6, 2019. You will be paid for this day.
- An evening Open House for all students will be held at the end of this program (TBD). Attendance at the Open House is mandatory for all teachers. Teachers will be paid for 2 additional hours for this event.
- All employees will be employees of AEF and receive Social Security credits; no PERS or STRS.
- You will be notified of the status of your application as early as possible and no later than May 15.
- All assignments are subject to sufficient class enrollments; AEF reserves the right to cancel classes based on low enrollment.



- All AEF teachers receive a 50% discount on AEF tuition fees for their children K-8 and/or high school.
- “Full time” Teachers will earn one (1) day (5.25 hours) of illness or injury leave for the summer school session and if not used during the summer session, shall be paid at the conclusion of the program at the regular hourly rate. Teachers working only one session (morning or afternoon) will also earn the equivalent of illness or injury leave.
- Teachers are expected to develop their own class curriculum and syllabus and provide them to the Summer Academy Principal prior to the start of the program. Classes should be fun, creative, enriching, and will not require students to complete homework. Teachers will report to the AEF Summer Academy Principal.
- The Summer Academy is being offered as an enrichment program for students from the Alhambra Unified School District and surrounding districts.
